Adj./Adv. as S + be/V ... 連接詞 as 可表「雖然」之意,但此用法較常 見於書面文章。此外, as 讓步子句僅置於主要子句之前, 並且會以倒裝 句形式出現,也就是將「修飾主詞的形容詞」或「修飾動詞的副詞」移至 句首,再接上 as S + be/V,意同 although S + be/V + adj./adv.,故本 句可改寫為 although it may seem incredible, he managed to ...。例 句: Fast as the girl ran, she couldn't catch up with her friend.
