**Objectives** Students in the class will attain and enhance competence in the four modes of literacy.

Reading: Students will...

- improve fluency skills, heighten their comprehension, and increase their reading speed through frequent reading of abridgments of classic English literature novels.
- expand their vocabulary through reading and studying accompanying glossaries.

Writing: Students will...

- strengthen their ability to write paragraphs, short essays, summaries, and journals.
- heighten their awareness of correct usage of English grammar in writing.
- improve their understanding of proper use of punctuation in writing.

Listening: Students will...

 learn strategies for improving their comprehension through repetitive, focused listening passages and activities.

Speaking: Students will...

- improve their ability to speak English more naturally through practicing speaking with appropriate volume and clarity, intonation, poise, eye-contact, and gestures.
- develop their confidence to converse in English in both formal and informal situations.
- become familiar with the processes of presentation preparation and delivery.

Homework Each student will have a login ID and password to access the Oxfords Wide Angle Online Practice website. The teachers will assist with the registration and explain the process. Each teacher will assign the specific homework for their class and the due dates.

Assessments The following examinations will be administered at the end of each of the six terms.

- Reading Comprehension Test (based on accompanying abridged novel)
- Vocabulary Test (based on *Glossary* of accompanying abridged novel)
- Writing Test (essay based on accompanying novel and skills learned in the term)
- Listening Test (based on skills practiced during the term)
- Speaking Test (based on skills practiced during the term)

#### Grades Students will earn end of term grades based on the following criteria and weight.

Listening Grade:

- 25% In-class performance, behavior, and participation
- 25% Assignments and Online Homework
- 50% Listening Test

Reading and Writing Grade:

- 40% In-class performance, behavior, and participation
- 20% Vocabulary Test
- 20% Reading Comprehension Test
- 20% Writing Test

Speaking Grade:

- 50% In-class performance, behavior, and participation
- 50% Speaking Test
- Course The class will be divided into three groups of 12 to 15 students for the Reading, Writing, and Listening classes, which will meet three times per week on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.

The class will be divided into eight groups of five to six students for the speaking classes, which will meet once per week on Mondays.
