Oxford Bookworms Frankenstein	<p>Reading Comprehension: Upon successful completion of this class students are able to...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ identify characters in the story and describe the individual characteristics of the people in the story.▪ describe the significant events in the story.▪ understand underlying themes of the story. <p>Writing: In this class, students will learn and practice ...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ proper paragraph format.▪ proper comma uses in writing. (i.e. city, country / formal date / lists / relative, restrictive, nonrestrictive clauses)▪ proper subject-verb agreement, to include past participle verb forms and past perfect tense. <p>Vocabulary: (<i>See Glossary, page 56, Frankenstein</i>) In this class student will be introduced to and be responsible for learning the assigned vocabulary. This includes learning...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ the English definitions.▪ how to use the vocabulary words in sentences.▪ how to correctly spell the vocabulary words.
<p>Expectations, Assessments, and Grading:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Participation: 40% Students are expected to come to each class on time with the proper materials (book, notebook, pen, etc.), stay alert, and actively participate in the class activities and discussions.▪ Vocabulary and Reading Comprehension Test: 40% Questions on the test may consist of multiple choice, matching, true/false, fill-in-the-blank, and straight answer questions.▪ Writing Test: 20% Students will be required to complete a timed, written test that will be directly related to the book, Frankenstein. Students will be required to demonstrate proficiency in proper subject-verb agreement.
